During one weekend it is possible to obtain 2× CAJC and 2× CAC and, with two critiques, fulfil one of the conditions for breeding approval (according to KCHLS breeding regulations).

Entry deadlines

Entries are accepted via the DOGOFFICE system only.

Entries and payments

- Entry of dogs is possible via DOGOFFICE only.
- After submitting the entry you will receive a confirmation e-mail. If you do not receive it, the entry has not been sent.
- Status in DOGOFFICE: NEW → after verification and payment matching COMPLETED. Statuses IN PROCESS / INCOMPLETE / RECEIVED mean the entry is being processed.
- Uploaded documents must be legible and complete (check readability of mobile photos).
- Pedigree is valid only if the owner is filled in and signed in the appropriate section. Upload both sides of the pedigree in DOGOFFICE.
- For Working Class, attach an official Working Certificate issued by ČMKJ (not a trial result table, diploma or hunting utility card).
- Entries sent by e-mail/post or after the III. deadline will not be accepted. To qualify for the fee of a given deadline, both the entry and the payment must be completed by that date.
- If the payment does not contain the correct variable symbol generated by DOGOFFICE, it may not be matched to your entry. Always use the correct VS; in the message to recipient include the owner's name.
- Entry forms will be available for download in DOGOFFICE usually about one week before the show.

Entry fees and cancellation

Without proof of payment, the entry will not be accepted.

In case of an incomplete entry, subsequent corrections and necessary correspondence, an administrative fee of EUR 5 may be charged upon entry.

Cancellation is possible until the III. deadline; 50% of the paid fee will be refunded.

Classes

- **Baby (Minor Puppy) class: 4–6 months;** grades: Very Promising (VN), Promising (N) or Less Promising (MN).
- **Puppy class: 6–9 months;** grades: VN, N or MN.
- **Veteran class: from 8 years.**
- **Junior class: 9–18 months;** CAJC may be awarded.
- **Intermediate class: 15–24 months;** CAC and res. CAC may be awarded.
- **Open class: from 15 months;** CAC and res. CAC may be awarded.
- **Working class: from 15 months;** CAC and res. CAC may be awarded (working certificate required).
- **Winner class: from 15 months;** CAC and res. CAC may be awarded (title eligibility required).
- **Honour class: from 15 months;** without CAC; graded and placed; EX1 qualifies for BOB/BOS competitions.

Titles and awards

In rings – Saturday 16 May 2026

- **Best Minor Puppy of Breed (BOMP)** – VN1 male and VN1 female from Baby class.
- **Best Puppy of Breed (BOP)** – VN1 male and VN1 female from Puppy class.
- **CAJC** – may be awarded to males and females graded EX1 in Junior class.
- **Club Junior Winner** – may be awarded to CAJC winners (male and female).
- **CAC** – may be awarded to EX1 males and females in Intermediate, Open, Working and Winner classes.
- **res. CAC** – may be awarded to EX2 males and females in Intermediate, Open, Working and Winner classes.
- **Club Winner** – competed for by males and females awarded CAC (Intermediate, Open, Working, Winner).
- **BOJ – Best Junior** (male or female) among CAJC winners.
- **BOV – Best Veteran** (male or female) among EX1 veterans.
- **BOB / BOS** – according to ČMKU/FCI show regulations (from winners of relevant competitions).

In rings – Sunday 17 May 2026

- **Best Minor Puppy of Breed (BOMP)** – VN1 male and VN1 female from Baby class.
- **Best Puppy of Breed (BOP)** – VN1 male and VN1 female from Puppy class.
- **CAJC** – may be awarded to males and females graded EX1 in Junior class.
- **CAC** – may be awarded to EX1 males and females in Intermediate, Open, Working and Winner classes.
- **res. CAC** – may be awarded to EX2 males and females in Intermediate, Open, Working and Winner classes.
- **Vysočina Region Winner 2026** – competed for by males and females awarded CAC (Intermediate, Open, Working, Winner); veterans do not participate.
- **BOJ – Best Junior** (male or female) among CAJC winners.
- **BOV – Best Veteran** (male or female) among EX1 veterans.
- **BOB / BOS** – according to ČMKU/FCI show regulations.

Final competitions (afternoon)

- **Child & the dog (3–9 years)** – handling is assessed; the dog does not have to be judged in the show.
- **Best couple** – male and female of the same breed owned (or co-owned) by the same person; both must be judged at the show.
- **Best breeders group** – 3 to 5 dogs of one breed from one kennel; from at least two different sires or dams; all must be judged at the show.
- **BIS Minor Puppy** – all minor puppies of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Very Promising.
- **BIS Puppy** – all puppies of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Very Promising.
- **BIS Veteran** – winners of BOV.
- **BIS Junior** – winners of BOJ.
- **Best Working Dog** – Working class dogs graded EX1, CAC.
- **BIS Honour** – Honour class dogs graded EX1.
- **BIS** – winners of BOB.

Results from final competitions are not recorded in the pedigree.

Documents required for participation

- entry confirmation / entry form (from DOGOFFICE)
- dog's pedigree
- vaccination certificate or pet passport (valid rabies vaccination)

Veterinary conditions

- All dogs must be clinically healthy.
- Dogs must have valid rabies vaccination in accordance with Czech veterinary legislation (Act No. 166/1999 Coll., on veterinary care, as amended) and related regulations.
- Dogs from EU Member States (and, according to movement rules, selected third countries) must be accompanied by a valid pet passport. Movements within the EU are governed by Regulation (EU) No 576/2013 and Implementing Regulation (EU) No 577/2013.

Instructions for completing entries

- If the required working certificate or eligibility for Winner class is not provided, the dog will be placed in Open class.
- Documents are not returned.
- A dog can be entered in one class only. Reclassification after the closing date is not possible.
- The age of the dog must be reached on the show day; other conditions (working certificate, titles, etc.) must be fulfilled on the date of entry submission.
- The online catalogue will be available for download on the show day from 06:00 on the show website.

General conditions

- The show is open to males and females of all retriever breeds (FCI Group VIII) registered in stud books recognized by FCI, who have reached the required age for the entered class.
- The organizer is not responsible for damages caused by a dog or exhibitor, nor for loss or death of a dog. Free running of dogs in the showground is not allowed.
- Females in advanced pregnancy, nursing females and dogs after surgical or other veterinary procedures performed to remove an exterior fault are not admitted.
- It is forbidden to treat the coat, skin or nose with anything that changes their structure, colour or shape. Only trimming, cutting, combing and brushing are allowed. Violation may result in exclusion.
- Double-handling (loud encouragement, toys, whistles, food etc. from outside the ring) is forbidden; in case of violation, the dog will not be judged.
- Photos and videos may be taken at the show. By attending the event, the participant agrees that they may be captured; if you do not wish this, please inform the photographer.
- Owners of dogs awarded BOB are obliged to take part in the final parade of winners.
- Unless stated otherwise, the FCI International Show Rules and the ČMKU Show Rules apply. If the show cannot take place due to objective reasons, the fees will be used to cover expenses.
- Bringing puppies (except puppies entered in the show) for sale and selling puppies at the show is prohibited.

Complaints

- A complaint against the judge's decision is not admissible.
- A complaint can be submitted for formal reasons only (breach of show rules or propositions).
- The complaint must be submitted in writing before the end of judging, together with a deposit of EUR 110. If the complaint is rejected, the deposit is forfeited in favour of the organizer.
